

TREES REQUIRED FOR THE SITE.

Many of you have already planted trees at the school or may have trees waiting to plant. We intend to start planting in October 2009. So if anybody has trees they would like to plant on the site please could you contact us and let us know what you have.

Below are listed the varieties we would like. We would like to keep to native trees. Some native trees have been removed from the list where we feel they are not suited to the site.

Trees and plants that are native to the UK are the backbone of our wildlife's food chain. Native insects and birds have evolved with them and find it hard to survive without the food and shelter they provide.

Any trees underlined are ones that we would particularly like.
We would also like some Elm saplings if anyone has any.
